Next Sunday - 12 July

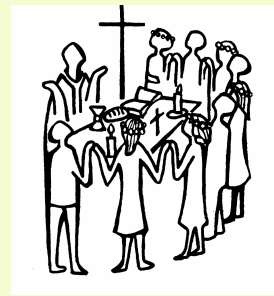
10 am **Trinity 10:** Our Reader Dr Bip Choudhury preaches at this service as we celebrate Holy Communion.
