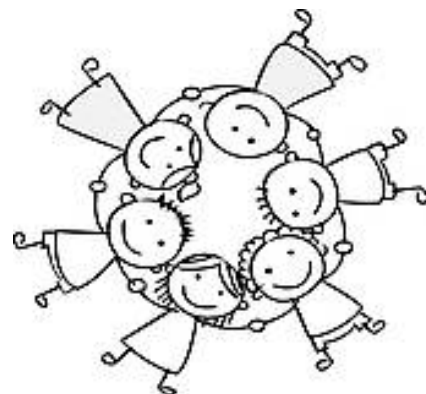
Church Toddler Group
