Just to remind you that the church Fairtrade Stall will be open in the hall after worship on Sunday selling Easter cards. The stall takes cash or card. Thank you for your support.

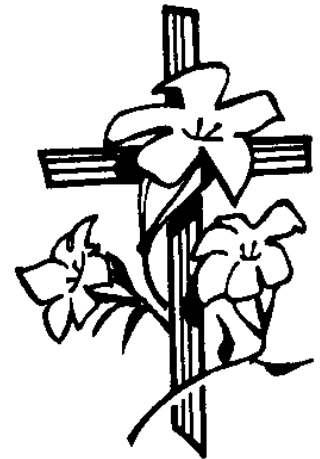
