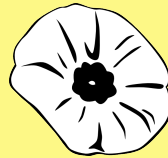

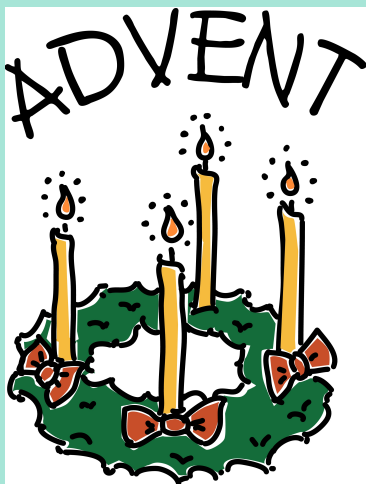

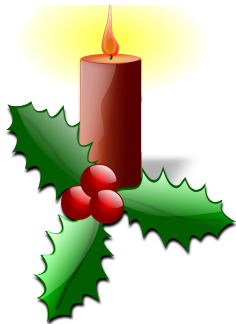


Christmas Fair
