Our Eco Group would like us all to take part: The RSPB's Big Garden Birdwatch (Friday 23-Sunday 25 January) is the world's largest garden wildlife survey! Last year, nearly 600,000 people took part and over nine million birds were counted.

We've lost a staggering 38 million birds from UK skies in the last 60 years. To take part, spend one hour counting the birds you see in one location – your garden, balcony or a local park.
