10 am **Trinity 15:** We celebrate God's love for us during our service of Holy Communion.

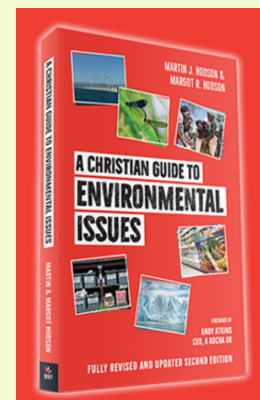
Next Sunday - 20 September
